Of course, the children will be expected to read their reading books as often as possible. Reading books are changed on Monday, Wednesday and Friday. Mrs Croll (our lovely volunteer) will read with the children on Wednesday afternoons, so it would be great if all children could have their books in on this day.

Thank you very much for all the 'Great Fire of London' homework we have received over last half term. The children love to share their homework with each other. They have been so proud of their work and we thank you so much for your continued support.
