- abseiling teddy – use wire/string and a clip to send your teddy along a line from your bedroom window.
- Toast marshmallows over a fire – use small sticks and a ring of bricks to safely make a fire in the garden (parental supervision needed)
- Build a den
- Make a cowboy sandwich: bread, bacon, beans, onions, cheese, sliced potato, ketchup. Wrap in foil and cook on a campfire (or under the grill!)
- Go on a long walk: throw stones in the river/sea. Pack your own bag for this- with a time limit. Make a list of all the equipment you will need and make sure you don't forget anything
- Archery- create some targets (box, hoops etc.) Throw objects into them and see how many points you can get.
- Try and travel from one side of the room to the other without touching the floor: what equipment could you use?
- Swim in the river/sea- with parents watching!! (Canoe in the bath!!)
- Make your own tea and tidy up after everyone
- Design own obstacle assault course- inside or outside
- Ring a friend and tell vampire/ghost stories
- Build a mini raft and sail it- in the bath/paddling pool

- Play Pooh sticks
- Do some research about berries/flowers/plants that are edible
- Skim stones on the lake/river/sea
- Find interesting pebbles at the beach and start a collection
- Play hide and seek in your house/on a walk
