	<i>Activity:</i>	Watch the teachers read the story 'hole at the bottom of the sea'. Using the pictures in your pack, can you order the pictures into the animal food chain from the story? Challenge – could you write a sentence about what one of the sea creatures eats?	<i>Activity:</i>	Watch the teacher video 'Monday patterns'. Can you join in with some of the movement patterns we make? Can you describe what patterns we made? Talk about what would come next in our pattern. Can you make your own movement pattern like 'stand sit stand sit'.	<i>Activity:</i>	Using a cardboard box can you be creative and make an under the sea habitat. You might want to make some sea creatures, some sea weed, rocks etc. Look at the idea in the pack for some inspiration.
Tuesday	<i>Title:</i>	Habitats	<i>Title:</i>	Musical patterns	<i>Title:</i>	RE
	<i>Activity:</i>	Watch the video writing a sentence. Can you write a sentence about your habitat? How many fish have you got? Does it look cold, light, dark? Etc If you didn't make a habitat you can use the picture from the pack yesterday to write your sentence.	<i>Activity:</i>	Watch the teacher video 'musical patterns'. Can you join in with some of the musical patterns we make? Can you talk about what patterns we made? What would come next in our pattern? Can you make your own pattern like 'clap clap stomp'. If you have musical instruments at home you could use these.	<i>Activity:</i>	Listen to the story which Jesus told 'The wise man and the foolish man'. When you have finished the story, can you build 2 houses, one on rock and one on sand (or something to represent sand). Pour water over the houses to see which house was more stable
