




Bolton-le-Sands C of E Primary School Curriculum Newsletter

Super Sleuths

In **English**, we will be reading 'The London Eye Mystery' by Siobhan Dowd, hunting for clues in the text to find out what has happened to Salim! Later in the term, we will be reading, writing and performing poetry.



Our **Maths** work will focus on: Place value, number operations, fractions, ratio & proportion, perimeter & area, measurements, shape and statistics.

In **Science**, we will be learning about the classification of organisms including animals, plants and micro-organisms.

Our **Geography** work includes mapping, including grid references and contours, and fieldwork investigating the local area.


In **RE**, we will be exploring ideas about God in Christianity and other religions.

PE this term will be on **Tuesday and Fridays**, focusing on cricket and gymnastics. Please ensure your child has a full, named, PE kit in school each day which includes: a blue t-shirt, plain black shorts and pumps or trainers. Please ensure that earrings are not worn or can be removed on PE days.

Our **Computing** work will focus on programming, using Scratch & BBC Micro:Bits.

In **Art & Design**, we will be creating landscapes using the wet felting technique.

Our **Music** lessons will focus on the unit 'Keeping Healthy.'



In **PSHE**, we are focusing on Being my Best, including getting fit, independence and responsibility, and basic first aid.

'Out of this World' is our **French** topic, finding out about language used to describe people for space ID cards and describing the planets.

How can I help at home?

Please encourage your child to read regularly at home; we expect them to read at least four times per week.

Homework will be set on Google Classroom on Fridays to be completed by the following Wednesday. All children will receive English, maths and spellings.

All children have a Read Theory login and are expected to use this as much as possible to continue to improve their comprehension skills.

They are also encouraged to use Mathletics and Times Tables Rock Stars regularly and new activities are set each week.
