Absence and Holidays

As per our Attendance Policy, family holidays are <u>not</u> routinely authorised and any unauthorised absence of <u>5</u> days or more <u>will</u> result in the penalty notice procedures being processed. To help avoid a penalty notice, we strongly encourage parents to book family holidays out of term time, to avoid dental and medical appointments being booked in school time (where possible) and to ensure that your child is punctual in their arrival to school. If your child does require time out of school, our 'Application for Leave of Absence' forms are available on the website. Please complete these thoroughly and provide a minimum of 14 days' notice.

Uniform and Jewellery

This is a polite reminder that our uniform includes suitable, black, footwear (not trainers). Also, at BLS, we allow pupils to wear earrings so long as the following two rules are followed:

- 1) Earrings are small stud earrings only
- 2) Earrings are removed before PE sessions. (they cannot be covered and must be removed independently)

We have pupils at school with significant allergies to nuts and to horse hair.
