Going Paperless!

We are exploring ways of reducing paper letters and forms and are now using ParentPay more frequently. We advise that you regularly check your ParentPay accounts! We are also trialling the use of ParentPay for our afterschool club signup. This goes live today and is first come, first served. Please choose one or two clubs to allow space for everyone.

Year 3 Bushcraft Days

Our Year 3 children will be participating in their Outdoor Adventure Bushcraft Days on 2 and 3 May. They will experience canoeing on the canal as well as survival and orienteering skills in Thwaite Brow Woods. The activities will be led, in small groups, by Mr Haworth and Phil Longbottom of Big Adventure.

Walk to School Initiative

We have launched the WOW Walk to School initiative with our children and are conducting a daily survey to learn how children travel to school. At present, we are encouraging children to walk, scoot, cycle or park and stride to school at least once a week. We continue to encourage parents to park near the church and avoid parking on double yellow lines. The Parking Enforcement Team have attended on 19 occasions since January and issued 15 penalty notices for double yellow line infringements.

Our Brilliant Bay Project

During the summer term, the whole school will be taking part in a joint project based around our local area. Absence and Holidays

As per our Attendance Policy, family holidays are not routinely authorised and any unauthorised absence of 5 days or more will result in the penalty notice procedures being processed. To help avoid a penalty notice, we strongly encourage parents to book family holidays out of term time, to avoid dental and medical appointments being booked in school time and to ensure that your child is punctual in their arrival to school. WhatsApp

We experience issues brought into school relating to unkind and inappropriate WhatsApp messages sent via WhatsApp groups out of school hours. WhatsApp has a 16+ age restriction to protect vulnerable younger children – we strongly advise parents to regularly monitor their child's activity and talk to children about the dangers of using WhatsApp and the importance to stop and think before posting or forwarding anything.

School Dinner Money

The Local Authority have advised schools to make an increase to the daily school meal charge from £2.50 to £2.70. We are postponing this increase until **September 2024**. Therefore, please be aware that if your child is currently in Year 2, from September you will have to pay £2.70 per day for a school meal.
