Welcome to the summer term edition of the Curriculum Newsletter.

Our main theme this term is:

Our Beautiful Bay



Our Key Enquiry Question is:

Why is Morecambe Bay special?

As readers and writers, we will be studying and creating our own fantasy story based on the text 'How the Whale Became' by Ted Hughes. In non-fiction, we will be writing a discussion text on an environmental theme. We are also going to be looking at film and playscripts and poetry for performance regarding our local area.

As mathematicians, children will be learning about fractions, money, time, shape and statistics.

As scientists, we will be investigating light and rocks.

As geographers, exploring the region in which we live using field work of the local area. As historians, we will be focusing on Bolton-le-Sands and how it has changed over time. As artists, we will be looking at how we can represent our local area through sculpture.

In RE, the children will be looking at the Church in a wider sense and exploring places of worship from faiths other than Christianity.



As musicians, children will be learning about body percussion, composing and performing our own body percussion piece.

On Tuesday children will be swimming. Please remind yourselves of the letter previously issued.

PE will be on Friday; the children will be learning to bowl a ball underarm with accuracy and to apply simple tactics in a striking and fielding game. In summer 2, the children will be developing their athletics skills. Children must have a named school PE kit (plain shorts, blue t-shirt and pumps) in school everyday. Trainers and tracksuit bottoms for outdoor PE are also advised.

Our themes for PSHE this term will be 'Being my best' and 'Growing and changing'.

How can I help at home?

Reading books will be changed as frequently as possible. Please spend time, little and often, ideally daily, reading with your child.

Spellings will be sent home on a Monday, to be practised at home and tested the following Monday. Thank you for all your support so far with spelling!

Children are expected to practice their times tables (children have access to TT Rockstars to practise these). The children can also practise these using paper resources; whatever works best for them!
